CACT will be awarded to all sighthound breeds (FCI group X) and selected breeds of FCI group V – Pharaoh Hound, Cirneco dell'Etna, Podenco Ibicenco and Podenco Canario. BEST IN FIELD The title will be awarded to the dog with the highest score from all breeds.

Technique of pulling the lure:	of	Motor reel, closed circuit over pulleys
Conditions of participation:	of	According to FCI Regulations for International Lure Coursing Events, each dog entered to race must have a valid racing or coursing license. The muzzle is mandatory for all breeds. All competitors must strictly follow the race schedule, so the trouble-free progress of the race can be ensured. The FCI judging system is used.
Mandatory equipment for dogs:	for	The dogs will run in racing jackets in red and white colour without numbers or any other signs . The muzzles are mandatory for all breeds!
Organization of runs:	of	The selection of pairs of dogs for the first heat is made by random selection. In case of an uneven number of entries, the organizers will try to find a companion dog with a license to pair run where possible to avoid a solo run. If there is an uneven number of dogs in both genders or classes, female and male, which could otherwise run solo, will run together. In the second heat, the dogs will be arranged in pairs based on the first heat results (1+2, 3+4, etc.). The pairs will run in random order then.
Protest:		The protesting person must pay the race organiser a fee of 100 EUR, and the organiser will pay the fee back if the protest is legitimate and justified. The Lure Coursing Director and the judges are authorised to reject the protest. The organiser will write a Coursing report about the race and send it to the Coursing Committee with the protest description and its solution/results. It is not possible to enter a protest against the judges' decisions.

Veterinary conditions:		<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Every dog at the start must have a valid passport or a veterinary certificate and must be clinically healthy. 2. Every dog on the start must have a valid vaccination against rabies not less than 21 days before coursing and not longer than the producer's stated validity for the used rabies vaccination. 3. Every dog must have a valid PET PASSPORT. 4. Dogs older than 6 years and dogs younger than 2 years must pass the veterinary check before the second round. 5. Every dog at the start must be unmistakably marked by a microchip. The marking of a microchip must be according to norm ISO 11784 and a microchip is possible to control by reading the device according to norm ISO 11785.

		The dog's owner is obliged to take care of the actual condition of the dog and set the dog's performance appropriately. There is always an opportunity to withdraw the dog from the coursing.
Responsibility disclaimer		Neither the organiser nor the officials are responsible for injuries incurred by the dog owners, the dogs or the officials. Likewise, they accept no responsibility for escaped/lost dogs. The owner is not responsible for injury to another dog caused by his dog during the race. In all other cases, the owner assumes full responsibility for his dog.
Dope testing:		All kinds of doping are forbidden. The doping test follows § 1.9 FCI International race and coursing regulations and the National coursing rules of Slovakia.
Misconduct owners or handlers:	by or	All the dog owners/handlers must behave according to the following rules: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Do not let the dog free of the leash. • Do not cause property damage or material damage. • Eventually, do not interfere with the course of the race. The owner/handler whose dog breached one of these rules can be charged with a financial penalty of 25 EUR. The Lure Coursing Director and the judges are authorised to exclude and dismiss anyone from the race/event who does not follow the race officials' instructions, insults them, or behaves improperly without any fee's refund.
